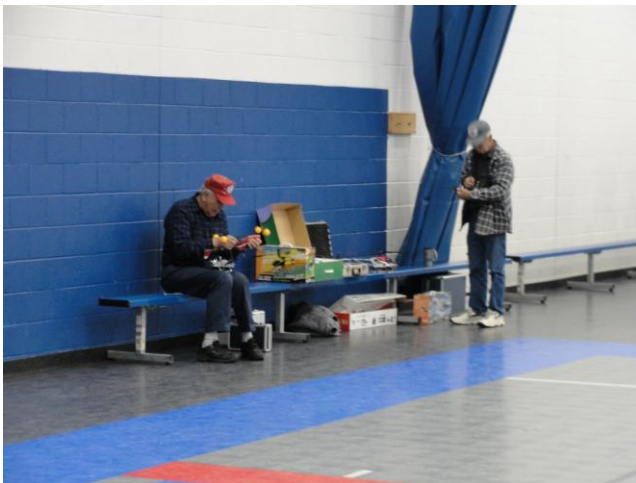

10 APRIL 2013

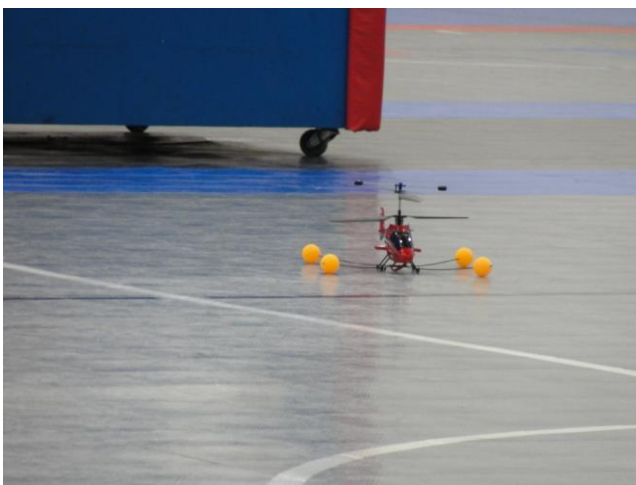

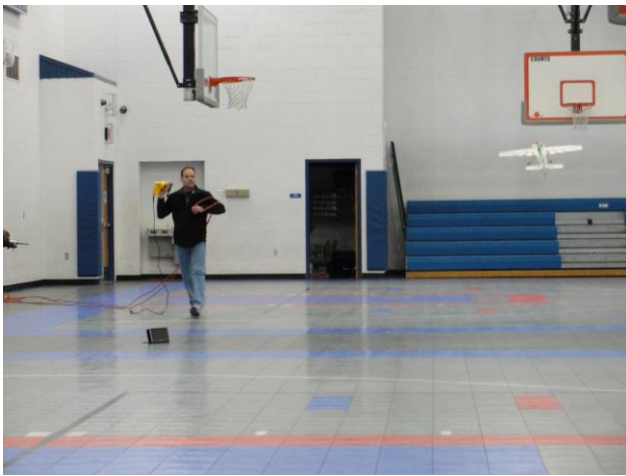

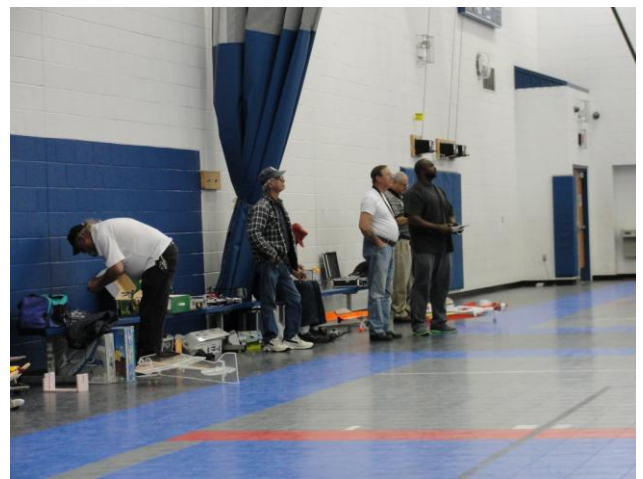

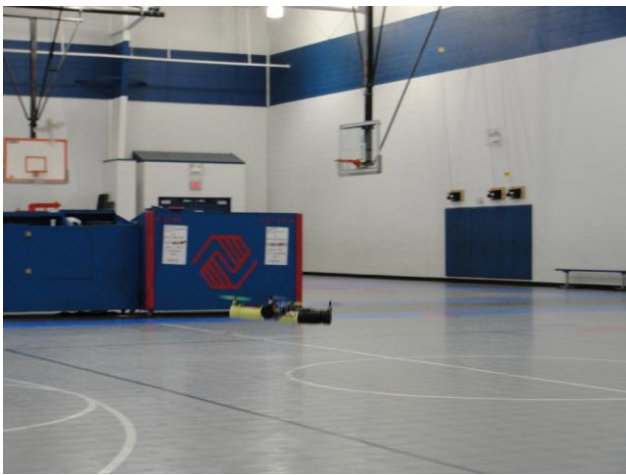
