



FIELD IRRIGATION – June 1984

Below are pictures of the irrigation system installed and used starting in June 1984. The pictures depict from the pick up point, the pump and then going up the hill to the field. At the field is the head that was made that split the water into several different lines. All pumping used PVC and had to be moved by club members from one location to another. Two club members did the moving of the sprinkler heads every four hours around the clock, day and night.









FIELD LOCATION MAPS

Third map to Hall Field






