### **New Members and Visitors**

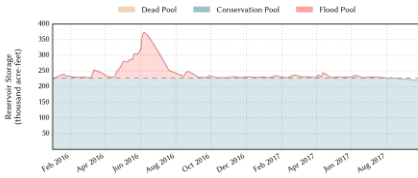
1. There were two new members this month.
